Need assistance forming a carpool or joining a vanpool?

You can quickly create a profile and then take advantage of available ridematching services to find commuters with similar work schedules who live and work near you to share a ride. The system maintains a database of individuals who have expressed an interest in sharing the ride to work. The database searches by home address, work address and work hours to find potential ridesharing partners for you, then lets you easily send potential carpool and vanpool partners an e-mail or give them a call. Interested in riding your bike to work? The system can even help you find a bike buddy. Best of all, these services are completely FREE.

Need a Guaranteed Ride Home from work?

When situations arise that prevent you from riding home in your carpool or vanpool, such as unscheduled overtime or emergencies, you can get a FREE Guaranteed Ride Home from The Clean Air Campaign. CARPOOL REWARDS

Already carpooling? Add more people and earn free gas.
Carpools with three or more people can earn monthly gas cards of \$40 or \$60. Participation is easy. Just have each carpool member log his or her carpool trips each week. Carpools that log at least 15 carpool days with three or more riders during the month can receive up to 12 monthly gas cards. 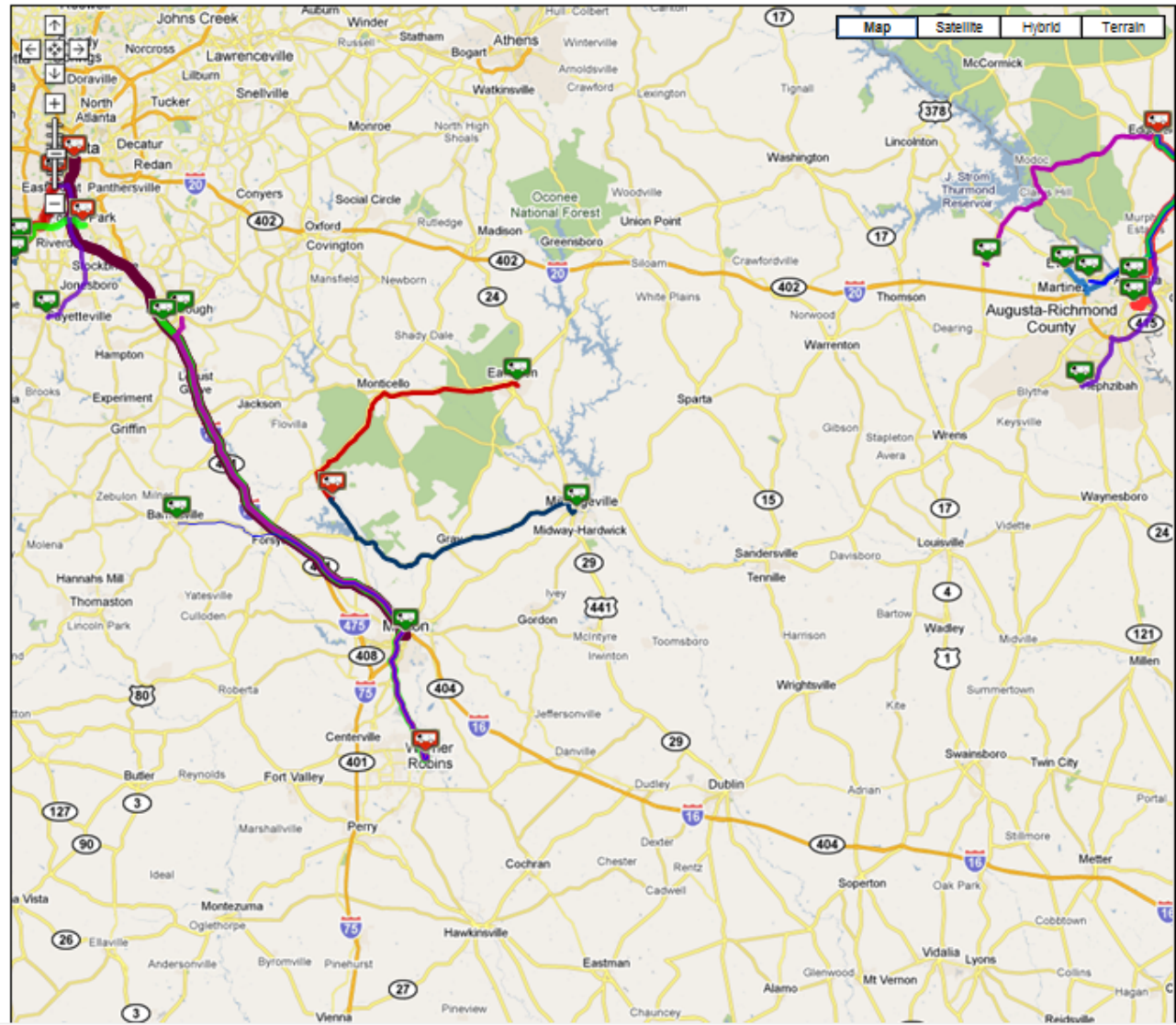

Commute Diary Tips

- Please submit a log for each day that you work.
- Please log any day that you do not work due to a compressed work week schedule (for example - if you work four 10-hr days and have the 5th day off - log that day as a Compressed Work Week Day Off).
- You may log the current day, or any of the most recent 7 days. You may not log days that are more than one week past.
- Click ENTER LOG on the day you wish to report. Your commute profile will automatically fill the log. Click 'SAVE
