- Discuss and Compile List of Potential Control Measures or Education & Outreach Initiatives
- Refine List of Potential Control Measures or Education & Outreach Initiatives into Categories

  - Harder to Implement
- Assign Multiple Group Members to Start Implementing “Easy to Implement” Measures.
- Assign Multiple Group Members to Research Strategies to Implement “Harder to Implement” Measures
- Assign Group Member to Report on Results of the Meeting to Project Coordinator
